



## *Associate or Full Professor (Clinical), McGill Director of the Division of Cardiology, Isadore Rosenfeld Chair in Cardiology (C-201127)*

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### **Position description**

The Department of Medicine at McGill University invites applications for a full-time position at the rank of Associate or Full Professor (Clinical) as a member of the Contract Academic Staff. The professorial rank will be determined according to the candidate's qualifications and experience. The incumbent will also be the McGill Director of the Division of Cardiology. The Department seeks a transformational leader who will take a high performing Division to the next level of academic excellence. This position does not confer eligibility for tenure.

The successful candidate will have a clear vision of the evolving nature of Cardiology, a demonstrated ability to communicate that vision, and the skill to encourage others to share it. The department will support the successful candidate's appointment to the Isadore Rosenfeld Chair in Cardiology in McGill University's Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences. The prospective Chairholder is expected to be a world-class scholar in research and teaching in the field of cardiology at McGill University.

The Department of Medicine is a leader in academic medicine, and our educational and research missions support excellent and innovative clinical programs across our teaching hospitals. The McGill University Health Centre and the Jewish General Hospital are major teaching hospitals affiliated with the Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences.

### **Job Duties**

The successful candidate, as McGill Director of the Division of Cardiology, will have a demonstrable record of success in academic leadership and draw on strong interpersonal skills to inspire best practices and innovation. They will foster excellence in teaching, patient care, and research within the Division and will demonstrate a commitment to equity, diversity, and inclusion in these activities. The incumbent will also promote independent and collaborative research, and fulfill administrative responsibilities at the institutional, university, regional and provincial levels, where appropriate.

The incumbent will be expected to maintain a clinical practice at the McGill University Health Centre and the Jewish General Hospital.

The McGill Division Director will ensure the pursuit of a common academic agenda for McGill Cardiology at all its sites, including a focus on the following aspects:

- 1) Education, specifically undergraduate and postgraduate initiatives in Cardiology;
- 2) Research, including promoting, supporting, and incentivizing McGill-wide Cardiology research initiatives;
- 3) Clinical innovation;
- 4) Faculty development, mentorship, and wellness; and
- 5) Cross-cutting advancement initiatives.

### **Qualifications and Education Requirements**

Candidates must hold an MD degree and have completed subspecialty training in Cardiology, be certified by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada (or equivalent), and be eligible for licensure by the Collège des médecins du Québec.

Candidates must have strong leadership qualities and must demonstrate internationally-recognized academic accomplishment in cardiology research and teaching. Preference will be given to a proven and accomplished clinical trialist.

All candidates must be fluent in English with a working knowledge of French.
