**Adult Cardiac Surgeon**

Applications are invited for an Adult Cardiac Surgeon with the Libin Cardiovascular Institute of Alberta and the Department of Cardiac Sciences at Alberta Health Services and the University of Calgary. The Section of Cardiac Surgery performs approximately 1,650 major cardiac procedures per year. The ideal candidate must be a graduate of a Canadian medical school or equivalent and must hold certification from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada (or equivalent) in the Specialty of Cardiac, Cardiovascular, or Cardiothoracic Surgery. Eligibility for licensure in the Province of Alberta is required. The successful candidate will have completed at least one year Fellowship- level training (post-FRCSC or equivalent) in cardiac surgery and have a minimum of 5 years of independent clinical practice. Experience in MIVS and TAVR would be an asset and highly desired. The successful candidate will participate in the Calgary Cardiac Surgery Clinical Alternate Relationship Plan (ARP), which provides competitive salary support and be part of a defined group work schedule with specific deliverables. He/she will actively partake and contribute to the teaching, research and clinical activities of the Section of Cardiac Surgery. Eligibility for medical licensure in the Province of Alberta is required.

The successful candidate will be part of the Libin Cardiovascular Institute of Alberta. Current membership includes over 100 principal investigators and their research teams with a broad range of interests in Cardiovascular Medicine. The Institute is housed within the rapidly growing Cumming School of Medicine, which has recently added two new research complexes to its already outstanding facilities. Calgary is a vibrant, multicultural city of more than 1,300,000 persons. Health care facilities provide service to a regional population of approximately 2,000,000.
