

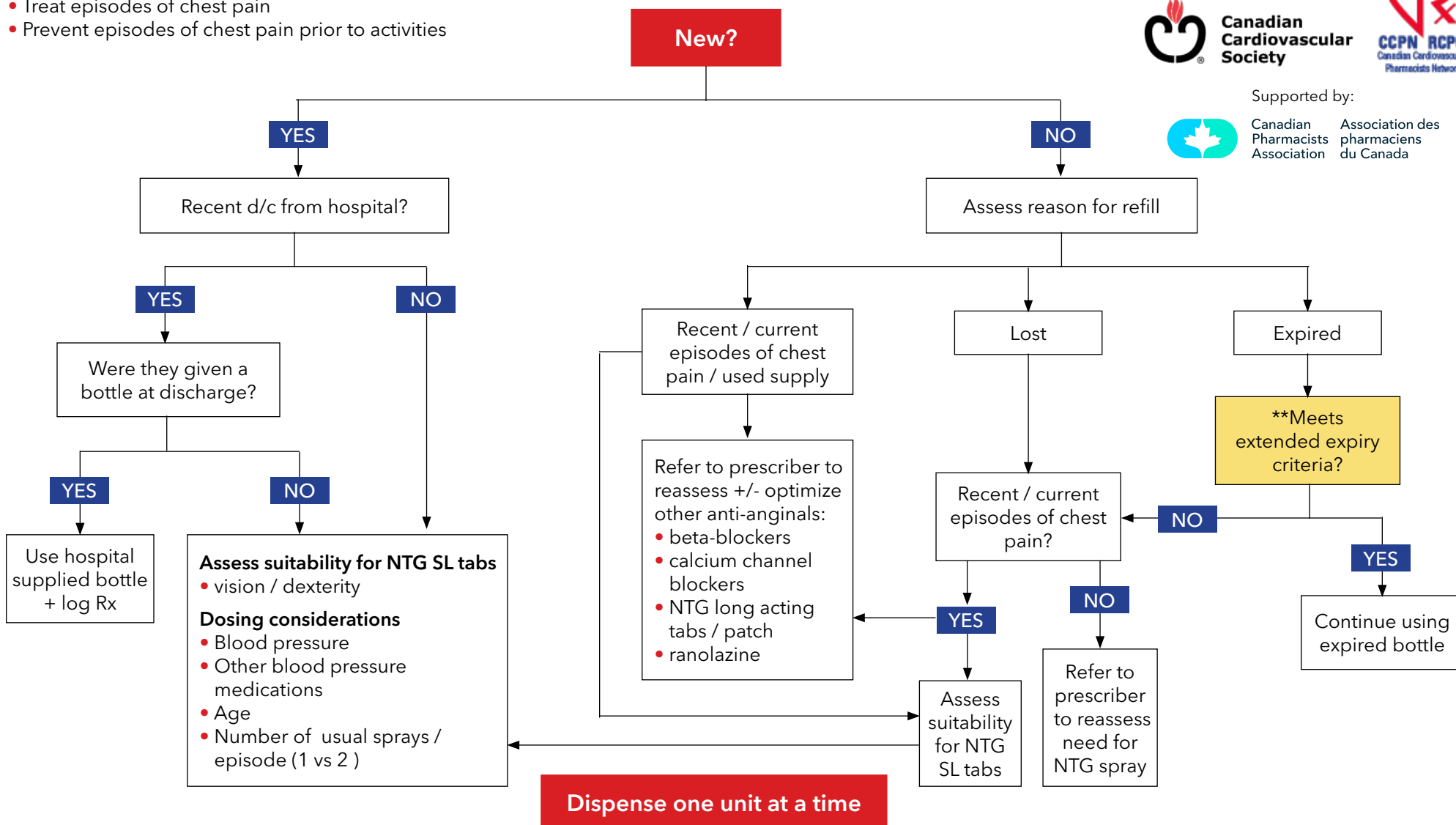
Patient presents with prescription for nitroglycerin (NTG) spray or requests NTG spray (Schedule 2 drug)

Uses for short acting NTG:

- Treat episodes of chest pain
- Prevent episodes of chest pain prior to activities
