TRPs help trainees prepare for the rigorous RCPSC exam. Both the **Pediatric Cardiology & Adult Cardiology** TRPs took place virtually in April 2022. Due to an exam scheduling change, a second **Pediatric Cardiology** TRP was held in-person in Edmonton in December 2022, followed by the **Cardiac Surgery** TRP, held in-person in Winnipeg in February 2023.
