

THE CANCARE SOCIETY EXCELLENCE IN CARDIAC CRITICAL CARE RESEARCH AWARD GUIDELINES

In 2015, The CANCARE Society established the CANCARE Society Excellence in Cardiac Critical Care Research Award to recognize excellence in cardiac critical care research. Applicants submitting their research abstract in the critical care field to the Canadian Cardiovascular Congress (CCC) will be given the opportunity to submit their abstract for the CANCARE Research Award under the 'Recognition, Awards, & Bursaries' task.

Selection Criteria:

Abstracts that are accepted for presentation at CCC will be considered. The recipient will be selected by CANCARE's Board of Directors or by a Committee selected by the Board of Directors based on the following criteria:

- 1. Quality of abstract;
- 2. Scientific question;
- 3. Rigour of methodology employed; and
- 4. Clinical or scientific originality and impact existing literature.

CANCARE will be in touch with all award candidates to gather source materials if needed to aid their selection process.

Award Prize:

The award will be presented at the CANCARE Annual General Meeting (AGM). The winner will receive a \$500 cash award, as well as an honorary plaque.

A call will go out annually to all CANCARE members adhering to the CCS Call for Science deadline for Abstract submissions.
