

HIGHEST RATED ELECTROPHYSIOLOGY ABSTRACT BY A TRAINEE AWARD GUIDELINES

The Canadian Heart Rhythm Society (CHRS) Highest Rated Electrophysiology Abstract by a Trainee Award was created in 2012. Applicants submitting their research abstract in the electrophysiology field to the CCC (using the Abstract Submission Portal) will be given the opportunity to submit their abstract for the CHRS EP Trainee Award. under the 'Recognition, Awards, & Bursaries' task.

Selection Criteria:

Abstracts that are accepted for presentation at CCC that are submitted to the CHRS EP Trainee Award will be considered; the trainee with the highest rated electrophysiology abstract will be selected as the winner.

Award Prize:

The award will be presented at the Canadian Cardiovascular Congress (CCC) at the CHRS Annual General Meeting. The winner will receive an honorary plaque.
