

CNCT Best Abstract Award Terms of Reference

The Canadian Society of Cardiovascular Nuclear and CT Imaging (CNCT) is a collaborative association of healthcare professionals and scientists that promotes excellence in clinical care, research, education, and advocacy in cardiovascular nuclear and CT imaging.

In 2016, CNCT established the Best Abstrct Award to recognize excellence in cardiovascular nuclear and CT imaging research.

A call will go out annually to all CNCT members adhering to the CCS Call for Science deadline for abstract submissions.

Eligibility Criteria:

- 1. Abstract submitted to the Canadian Cardiovascular Congress (CCC) in the field of cardiac imaging (Nuclear, PET, CT, echocardiography, MR); and
- 2. Clinical or basic science.

Regulations:

If the abstract is submitted from an Awards Committee Members' institution, or if an Awards Committee Member is identified as co-author of the abstract, an alternate CNCT member will be selected to serve on the Awards Committee.

Award Prize:

The award will be presented at the CCC at the CNCT Annual General Meeting (AGM). The winner will receive an honorary plaque.
